

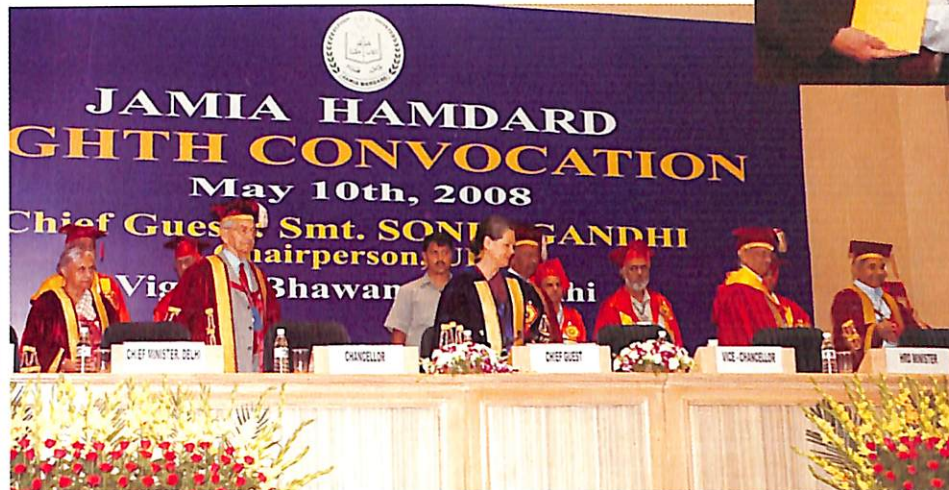

- Visit of UGC XIth Plan Team led by Prof BG Mulamani, VC, Gulbarga University



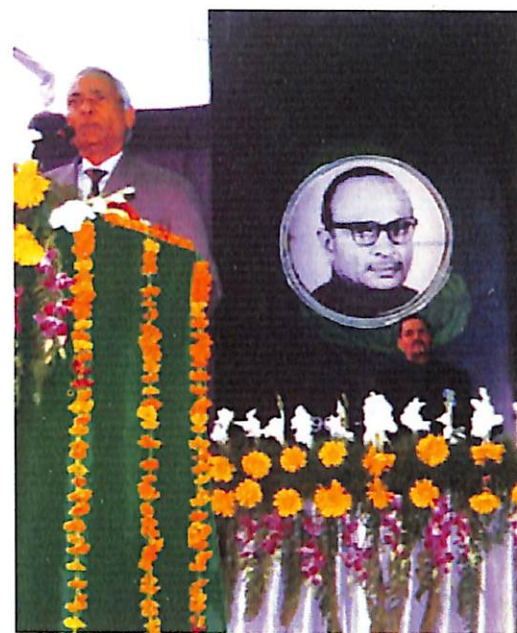
OUR NEW VICE CHANCELLOR

Dr GN Qazi joined as Vice Chancellor in October 2008 after serving a leading CSIR laboratory, Indian Institute of Integrative Medicine (IIIM), Jammu as its Director for over eight years. He obtained his post-graduate degree in Biochemistry and PhD in Microbiology from MS University, Baroda. He did his post-doctoral research at the University of Dortmund (Germany).

Dr Qazi has over 40 years of research experience in the frontier areas of biotechnology, herbal medicines and microbiology. He has published more than 200 papers in leading journals, several patents and guided a large group of researchers and post-doctoral fellows.

Dr Qazi is on the board of several national and international committees. He was instrumental in transforming the erstwhile RRL, Jammu into IIIM, one of the star laboratories of CSIR in a short period of time. His research philosophy has been focused on the product development, patenting and cutting-edge technology.

Dr Qazi is an able and visionary administrator with great scientific acumen which is generally a rare combination. Jamia Hamdard community is greatly enthused with his energy and vigour with which he wants to take the University to new heights. □

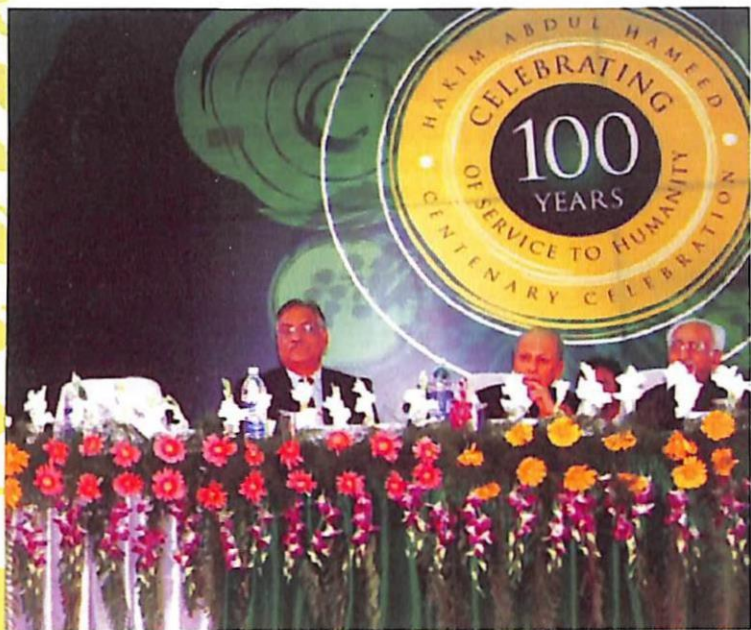

Birth Centenary Celebrations of Janab Hakeem Abdul Hameed Sahib



To mark the Birth Centenary of the Founder Chancellor, a grand function was organized in the Hamdard Archives and Research Centre Auditorium on the 16 Nov '08. A documentary on the Life and Works of Hakeem Sahib was shown to the audience. Indian and foreign students of Jamia Hamdard presented colourful cultural programmes on this occasion.

The Centenary Celebrations of the Hakeem Sahib began at the University Campus on the 27th Dec '08. On this occasion, Mr M Hamid Ansari, Vice President of India, unveiled the Hakeem Abdul Hameed Award for Outstanding Contribution in the Field of Natural Medicine. He also released the biography of Hakeem Sahib and a book titled 'Madar-e-Hamdard' written by Khwaja Hasan Nizami.

The Vice President said "I deem it a privilege to be the Chief Guest today to inaugurate the Birth Centenary Celebrations of Hakeem Sahib. This distinguished gathering of friends and admirers of Hakeem Sahib testifies to his enduring legacy to the nation and to his multifarious fields of interest in Unani medicine and therapeutics, education and research, Islamic culture and civilization, promotion of Urdu and public service for the needy and the downtrodden. For this reason, Hakeem Sahib can rightly be called a Mujaddid of Unani Medicine. Assuming the leadership of the institution at an unusually young age he, as all great men, led by example. His simple lifestyle bereft of any luxury, his walking to his office and his empathy for the poor are almost Gandhian relics from a bygone era. It was his love for education and the welfare of humanity that led him to focus on the Wakf. In our recent history he is probably the first, and the most successful, to resurrect the Wakf concept in innovative ways so that a modern company was registered as a Wakf institution, whose income was to be used for public good in the areas of education, medical relief and the

advancement of knowledge. It was an important signal in the immediate aftermath of the painful partition of India to thread together."

He further added, "In the decades since, over 25 educational and research institutions were established culminating in the Jamia Hamdard. The spectrum is astounding ranging from primary education to post-doctoral research, from Unani Medicine to Information Technology and from Islamic Studies to Business Management. Besides the university, the schools and hospitals established for service to society, there are a set of institutions that bear testimony to his scholarly interests. I refer to the Institute of History of Medicine, the Institute of Islamic Studies, the Ghalib Academy and the Institute of Federal Studies. Each of these has rendered significant service to scholarship. The Centenary Celebrations thus also serve as a reminder, hopefully as an inspiration, to others to follow in Hakeem Sahib's footsteps."

Mr Abdul Mueed, Chairman, Hamdard Laboratories also graced the occasion with a number of luminaries. Mueed Sahib's message was "Hakeem Sahib was a visionary, who saw the relevance of natural medicine to provide quality healthcare at affordable cost to the masses. The inception of Hakeem Abdul Hameed Award is a tribute to the life of Hakeem Sahib who fostered advancement in the field of natural medicine through scientific research. As the leading proponent of natural medicine, we at Hamdard believe that the torch lit by Hakeem Sahib must be carried forward for generations ahead. We hope the award will not only encourage research in natural medicines, both Unani and Ayurveda, but will also lead to the development of new formulations."

Prof Mohammad Amin, eminent historian and former Vice Chancellor, Jamia Hamdard spoke at length in chaste Urdu about some little known qualities of Hakeem Sahib, like avoiding to receive congratulatory messages in person and on the telephone when he was conferred with Padma Bhushan. This reminds one of Hakeem Sahib's famous sayings, inscribed in his tomb: 'For some inexplicable reason, titles and honours have all along chafed my soul'

Hakeem Abdul Hameed Award for Outstanding contribution in the field of natural medicine will include a recognition certificate along with a cash prize of Rs 3 lac. There would also be two runner-up awards with recognition certificates and cash prizes of Rs 2 lacs and 1 lac, respectively. Selection criteria for the award include contribution to the development of new formulations in area of Unani and Ayurveda supported by clinical research.

Children from schools presented a cultural programme signifying the cultural diversity of country, which was at the core of mission of Hakeem Sahib.

Dr GN Qazi, Vice Chancellor offered a vote of thanks to the Vice President of India, the panel of speakers and the audience. □

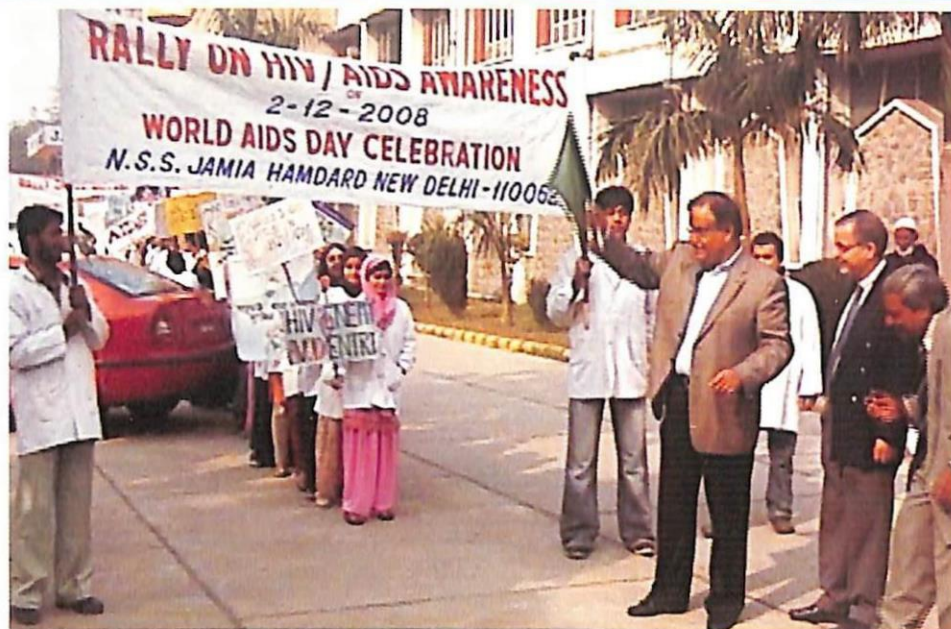
Pulse Polio

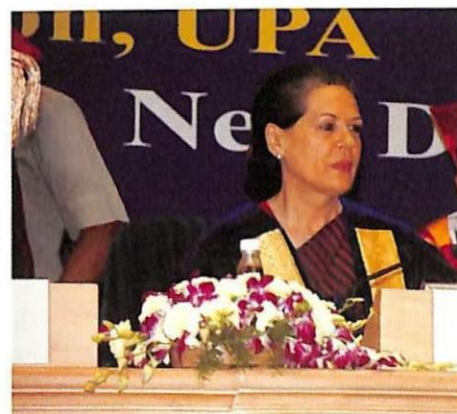
Nehru Park and Chanakya Puri, New Delhi.

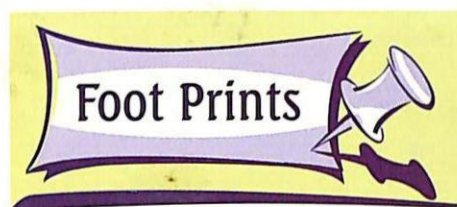
- The HMS Central Library organized Orientation programme for teachers and scholars on online resources available to library through UGC-INFLIBNET E-Journals consortium (Sep '08).
