7. What do you understand by concept of 'Possession'? What are the various theories supporting one or other concept of possession? What is role of possession in law and legal system? Refer to relevant case law.

8. Critically discuss the concept of possession with special reference to the contribution made to this concept by Savigny, Ihering and Salmond.

9. "Ownership in its most comprehensive signification, denotes the relation between person, and any right that is vested in him"- Salmond. Critically discuss the concept of ownership with special reference to this statement.

10. Ownership may be defined as the best right to possess. Do you agree? Give reasons for your answer.
